

The Manila Amendments
to the Annex to the
International Convention on Standards
of Training, Certification and
Watchkeeping for Seafarers
(STCW), 1978

Ms. Carmina C. Jocson attended and actively participated during the one-day seminar "The 1978 STCW Convention and Code (as amended)" held last November 16, 2019.

The International Convention on Standard Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers, 1978 (hereinafter referred to as "the Convention"), concerning the procedure for amendment by a Conference of Paties, Having Considered the Manila amendments to the Annex to the Convention proposed and circul; ated to the Members of the Organization and to all Par-

ties to the Convention.

I. Adopts, in accordance with article XII(I)(b)(ii). ammendments to the annex to the Convention, the next of which is set out in the annex to the present resolution;

2. Determines, that the amendments annexed hereto shall be deemed to

have accepted on I July 2011;

3. Invites, deemed to have accepted in accordance with paragraph 2 above;

4. Request, the Secretary-General of the Organization to transmit certified copies present resolution.

5. Further Request, the Secretary-General to transmit copies of this annex to all Members of the Organization which are not Parties to the Convention.




